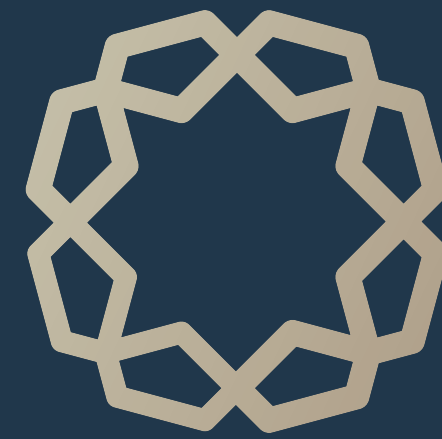

I. Overview

Dear Member,

My name is Piero Cattarini, member of la **Real Gran Peña** (Madrid-Spain) since 2004 and former member of the **Koninklijke Industriele Groote Club** (Amsterdam-Netherlands).

As a member of both, I have been involved simultaneously in organizing activities regarding young members.

In February 2017, I proposed to the young members and respective Board of Directors of both clubs the organisation on an Inter-Club event, whereby those young members would visit each other first in Madrid and after in Amsterdam.

With the enthusiastic backing of the Jongeren Tafel of the **Koninklijke Industriele Groote Club** and the further support of the young members of the **Real Gran Peña** we further decided to invite those other clubs from across Europe which shared a relationship with either of the clubs, in order to encourage their young members to join and participate.

As planned, this event took place in Madrid the weekend of the **26-28th of May of 2017** at **Real Gran Peña** premises. It was the **1st Young European Inter-Club Weekend** and the attendants' expectations were totally surpassed. A total of 10 clubs participated.

Following this first event, and as planned – the Jongeren Tafel of the **Koninklijke Industriele Groote Club** invited young members of the **Real Gran Peña** to visit their club the weekend of **27-28 October 2017**. A further 25 clubs were invited to participate in the occasion. The **2nd Young European Inter-Club Weekend** thus took place, once again surpassing all expectations – 80 members representing 25 clubs too part.

The following year, the **3rd Young European Inter-Club Weekend** took place, this time organised as a joint venture between the **Automobile Club de France** and the **Cercle de l'Union Interalliee**. Numbers attending rose significantly to **180 members from 38 clubs**. Feedback was hugely positive and the numbers of course suggested the growing arc of this new 'tradition'.

I. Overview

In the wake of Covid, our plans for 2020 naturally had to be scrapped, to the disappointment of all. Nevertheless, we resolved to come back even stronger when circumstances allowed. Accordingly, beginning in **January 2022**, with restrictions finally lifting, we were able to announce the next planned event – the **5th Young European Inter-Club Weekend**, held in London, UK, as a joint venture between **The Lansdowne Club**, **The National Liberal Club**, and the **University Women's Club**. Once again, expectations were surpassed, with 41 participating clubs from 12 countries and a total of 210 members.

The year 2022 concluded with an “additional” and more intimate **6th Young European Inter-Club Weekend** at the **Circolo Artistico Tunnel in Genoa**, Italy, from **15–18 September**. Conceived as a smaller gathering, it offered the rare pleasure of discovering an extraordinary historical city—rich in palaces and infused with the authentic essence of Italy, well beyond the usual tourist paths. Truly unforgettable.

2023 proved to be another highlight, with **The Helsinki Bourse Club** hosting an epic **7th Young European Inter-Club Weekend** from **21–24 September in Helsinki, Finland**. The event brought together 30 participating clubs and a total of 150 members in a vibrant and memorable Nordic setting.

The 8th **Young European Inter-Club Weekend**, held in Vilnius, Lithuania, was a great success and a deeply enriching experience for all involved. Hosted with remarkable dedication by the members of **Vilniaus Klubas**, the event offered not only warm hospitality but also an inspiring immersion into the city's unique character. Vilnius, with its UNESCO-listed Old Town, layered history at the crossroads of East and West, and strong traditions of intellectual life and cultural resilience, proved to be a perfect setting. From shared moments over midus, cepelinai, and suktinis to thoughtful exchanges shaped by Lithuania's rich historical narrative, we learned a great deal and strengthened the bonds that define our community.

And finally, looking further into the future, we are already excited to share that after nine years, the **9th Young European Inter-Club Weekend** will return to The Netherlands, taking place in The Hague at the distinguished **Club De Witte**. We very much look forward to meeting again our most motivated and close friends from the Netherlands.
